2011 REUNION EVENTS

EVENT A: WHITE HOUSE & VIP VETERANS TOUR

Friday, October 21st (9:00am-5:00pm)

A very special tour of the White House has been arranged. Don't miss this very rare opportunity to get a glimpse into the home of the United States President. The White House tour will include the first floor corridor, the *White House Library*, *The East*, *Blue*, *Green*, and *State Rooms* (tour stops subject to change, depending on activities in the White House during tour day). Prior to stepping inside the White House you will stop at the new *White House Visitor's Center*. The center features aspects of the White House, including its architecture, furnishings, first families, social events, and relations with the press and world leaders, as well as a thirty-minute video. Lunch will be on your own at a suitable location. Spend the afternoon touring some of the famous memorials in Washington, DC. Time permitting we will stop at the *United States Navy Memorial*, the *WWII Memorial*, *Korean Memorial* and the *Viet Nam Memorials*.

Please note: If you are interested in the taking this tour the following will be mandatory on your registration form: Social Security Number, date of birth, full name (including middle initials) as it appears on your government issued identification. You must have your photo identification with you on this tour. You will be denied admission if you do not have photo identification. The White House tour is subject to cancellation due to the state of the nation at tour time. If for some reason the tour is cancelled, it will be replaced with sightseeing in Washington, DC.

EVENT B: GROUP SEAFOOD BUFFET DINNER

Friday, October 21st (5:00pm-8:00pm)

Following the Washington, DC Tour (Event A) you will proceed directly to *Phillips Seafood Restaurant* for dinner. Located in the heart of the Baltimore Inner Harbor, Phillips' famous all-you-can-eat seafood buffet features a spectacular selection of fresh seafood, regional specialties and non-seafood options. There are over 50 seafood items as well as traditional menu items. Don't miss this chance to catch up with your friends and relax after a great day of sightseeing.

Please note: You will not return to the hotel between the Washington, DC tour and the group dinner. For those who do not want to go to dinner, the motor coach will take you back to the hotel where dinner & the evening will be on your own.

EVENT C: ANNAPOLIS, & THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY

Saturday, October 22nd (9:00am-3:00pm)

Annapolis, once the Nation's capital, remains much as it was, filled with historic taverns, restaurants, specialty shops and a splendid City Dock area. Begin your day at the venerable *U.S. Naval Academy* and step inside the Midshipman Officer Candidate's world. At the Visitor's Center and gift shop enjoy the movie – "To Lead and to Serve". Then begin your walking tour featuring a visit to the Chapel, referred to as the *Cathedral of the Navy* and the *Crypt of John Paul Jones-Father of the Navy*. Other highlights include the *Midshipman's Dorm* and the *Naval Museum*. Spend the afternoon in downtown Annapolis; where there will be time for lunch on your own, shopping and browsing the many unique shops & boutiques before returning to the hotel. Be sure to wear your walking shoes on this tour.

Please Note: Photo Identification is required to visit the Naval Academy.

Join your friends for the Banquet Dinner at the Hotel. Cocktails will be available from the cash bar at 6:00pm; dinner will be served at 7:00pm. Please make your entrée selection on the reservation form.

- ~ All tour times are subject to change. A final itinerary is available at registration.

Reservations are due by September 9th, 2011. Late reservations accepted on a space available basis with a non refundable \$10 per person late fee.
